Your Long Range Health Plan

See Your Health Care Provider 2-4 times per year:

- A-1-C testing 2-4 per year
- Comprehensive Foot exams
- Blood Pressure Management
- Cholesterol blood tests
- Kidney and Liver Function Tests
- Flu and Pneumonia Vaccinations
- Medication Adjustments

See Your Diabetes Education Team Annually:

- Healthy Meal Planning & Activity
- Understanding Diabetes Numbers & Setting Goals
- Medications
- Blood Glucose Monitoring
- Reducing Risk

- 1 - Covered when ordered by a physician with an appropriate medical diagnosis

3 hours for MNT the first year and 2 hours each subsequent year.

‡MNT- Medical Nutrition Therapy by a Registered Dietitian/ Nutritionist (RDN)
